- Two references (from teachers or mentors who are not related to you)

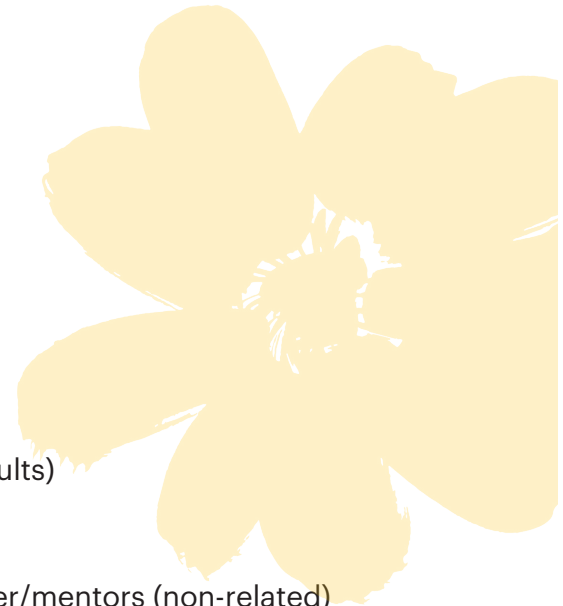

# Checklist and Guide for Applicants



## Step 1: Application and required documents (Due March 16, 2026)

- Complete, sign and return application (attached)
- Retrieve and send a copy of your required health records:
  - Flu (Varicella, proof of most recent vaccination)
  - MMR (mumps, measles, rubella)
  - Tuberculosis (QuantiFERON TB test — blood work with proof of results)
  - Doctor-signed waiver if unvaccinated for any reason
- Provide recommendation forms with 2 of your references from teacher/mentors (non-related)
- Without the use of generative AI, write/return a 200-word essay “I want to volunteer at Piedmont because...”
- Submit all via email attachments to [sydney.frazier@piedmont.org](mailto:sydney.frazier@piedmont.org)
- Please only submit documents once you have completed all the requirements listed above.  
Incomplete application packets will not be accepted

## Step 2: Planning for your interview

- Interviews will be held March 24, 2026, 4 PM to 7 PM.  
Applicants will be sent a link to sign up for a time slot
- Location: Piedmont Columbus Regional (Midtown Campus), Conference Center

- Youth Volunteer applicants will be notified of acceptance decision via email.

## Step 3: Accepted youth volunteers, pay program fee

- Uniforms are specific to Piedmont Columbus Regional. Full scrubs (top/pants), \$50 program fee If selected into the program you will submit payment and pick up your uniform at PCR Midtown Gift Shop, May 18-23, 2026.
- Prepare uniform in advance and wear your mandatory uniform to orientation

## Step 4: Placement details and orientation:

- You will receive email confirmation with details of your day(s)/placement
- Mandatory orientation: June 3rd, 2026, 1 PM to 5 PM **There are NO makeup dates.**  
Location: Piedmont Columbus Regional (Midtown) Conference Center
- Program runs June 15 — July 23, 2026  
(Weekly shift, Monday–Thursday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.)
